## Text Banking

### Send us a text, and we'll send you your balance

With our Mobiliti Mobile Banking Text Banking/SMS (Short Message Service or "SMS"), basic account information is just a text away. Use simple text commands to receive instant account information when you are on the go—it's simple, quick, convenient and secure. \*

#### How it Works:

1. Send us a text message to request account information. (Short code **99588**)
2. In the message field, enter a text banking command.
3. Receive a text message reply from us.
4. View your current balance and recent transactions.

#### Text Banking Commands:

Send the following simple text command to 99588.

- **BAL** [Get balances for all enrolled accounts]
- **HIST + account nickname** (ex. HIST C1) [Get recent transactions]
- **MORE** or **NEXT** [Use after a HIST command to receive additional transactions]
- **ATM + Street or Zip** [Find ATMs within that area]
- **BRANCH + Street or Zip** [Find branches within that area]
- **HELP** [Provides a list of text commands]
- **STOP** [Unsubscribe from text banking]

**Note:** Your account nicknames are set up online, under your Mobile Banking settings. Text BAL to see the nicknames of your enrolled accounts.

### How to Enroll:

**Note:** You must be registered with our Resurgens Online Banking in order to use Text Banking. If you are not enrolled, [click here](#) to quickly and securely get signed up.

- From a computer, sign into your Online Banking account at [www.resurgensbank.com](http://www.resurgensbank.com).
- Click on the “Options” tab, then go to the “Manage Device(s)” box and click on **“Mobile Banking”**.
- Register your mobile phone if needed. If already registered, select from drop down “Change your Mobile Banking Services” and modify as needed.
- Add the service “Text Messaging”. \*\*

\* Messaging and Data Rates May Apply. Check with your mobile phone carrier for details.

\*\* In order to receive text messages back, you need be able to accept SMS messaging in the form of Short Codes. Check with your wireless provider for possible data charges and compatibility.
